

Explanation of how funding request fits into Beneficiary’s Mitigation Plan (5.2.1):

The primary goal of North Dakota’s Beneficiary Mitigation Plan is to reduce NO_x emissions. The transition to new, and therefore cleaner, diesel powered vehicles is one means of reducing NO_x emissions in the state of North Dakota. In addition, under North Dakota’s listing of the Eligible Mitigation Actions, North Dakota estimates that between 25 and 50% of eligible mitigation funds will be spent on Class 4-7 Eligible Medium Trucks (Category 6).

Detailed Description of Mitigation Action Item Including Community and Air Quality Benefits:

As the beneficiary, the NDDEQ, Division of Air Quality personnel held multiple public comment periods and public meetings to hear what the citizens of North Dakota would prefer North Dakota’s portion of the settlement funds be spent on. There was interest in both vehicle replacements and expanding electric vehicle charging capabilities. The current proposed mitigation action plans to partially fund the replacement of a 2006 gravel truck with a new truck, which will reduce NO_x emissions and improve the air quality in North Dakota.

Estimate of Anticipated NO_x Reductions:

The Environmental Protection Agency’s Diesel Emissions Quantifier was used to determine emission reductions from the replacement of a 2006 Category 6 truck. The following lifetime emission reductions were determined:

If applicable, describe how the mitigation action will mitigate the impacts of NO_x emissions on communities that have historically borne a disproportionate share of the adverse impacts of such emissions:

As is described in North Dakota’s Beneficiary Mitigation Plan, there are no areas in North Dakota that have been designated as nonattainment for any State or Federal ambient air quality standards. Therefore, North Dakota did not request that applications be submitted for specific regions within the state. Instead, North Dakota worked to spread the vehicle replacements across the state in a manner that will provide the greatest benefit to all North Dakota residents. Therefore, emissions reductions will be spread across the state.

ATTACHMENT C

DETAILED PLAN FOR REPORTING ON ELIGIBLE MITIGATION ACTION IMPLEMENTATION

The North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality, Division of Air Quality (NDDEQ) will provide detailed reporting on the Volkswagen Environmental Mitigation Trust in two ways:

1) Timely updates to the NDDEQ's Volkswagen Settlement webpage
(<https://deq.nd.gov/AQ/planning/VW.aspx>)

2) North Dakota's semiannual reporting obligation to Wilmington Trust (the Trustee).

North Dakota maintains a website for the North Dakota Department of Environmental Quality, which is meant to keep the public informed about topics of interest. The Air Quality Division, which is the lead agency acting on behalf of the beneficiary, maintains a Volkswagen Settlement website, which is updated periodically with information about the Division of Air Quality's progress on use of the Settlement funds. The Division of Air Quality plans to use this website to provide updates as part of our reporting requirements and to keep the public informed of our progress.

Subparagraph 5.3 of the Environmental Mitigation Trust Agreement for State Beneficiaries details North Dakota's Reporting Obligations: "For each Eligible Mitigation Action, no later than six months after receiving its first disbursement of Trust Assets, and thereafter no later than January 30 and July 30 of each year, each Beneficiary shall serve upon the Trustee, a semiannual report describing the progress implementing each Eligible Mitigation Action during the six-month period leading up to the reporting date (including a summary of all costs expended on the Eligible Mitigation Action through the reporting date). Such reports shall include a complete description of the status (including actual or projected termination date), development, implementation, and any modification of each approved Eligible Mitigation Action. Beneficiaries may group multiple Eligible Mitigation Actions and multiple sub-beneficiaries into a single report. These reports shall be signed by an official with the authority to submit the report for the Beneficiary and must contain an attestation that the information is true and correct and that the submission is made under penalty of perjury. To the extent a Beneficiary avails itself of the DERA Option described in Appendix D-2, that Beneficiary may submit its DERA Quarterly Programmatic Reports in satisfaction of its obligations under this subparagraph as to those Eligible Mitigation Actions funded through the DERA Option. The Trustee shall post each semiannual report on the Trust's public-facing website upon receipt."

In North Dakota's semiannual reporting, following the Trustee's approval of this project, the Division of Air Quality will describe the progress of implementing the Category 6 eligible mitigation action. The semiannual report will include a summary of all costs expended on the Category 6 eligible mitigation action, in addition to any other eligible mitigation actions, which are also funded through the reporting date. The report will also include a complete description of the status, development, implementation, and any modification to any eligible mitigation actions.




