### <u>Detailed Description Of Mitigation Action Item</u> <u>Including Community And Air Quality Benefits (5.2.2)</u>

The Confederated Tribes and Bands of the Yakama Nation ("Yakama Nation") is pleased to submit the Yakama Nation's Round 1 School Bus Replacement Project ("Project") under the Environmental Mitigation Trust Agreement for Indian Tribe Beneficiaries dated November 30, 2018 ("Indian Tribe Trust Agreement"). The Project is primarily submitted under Section 2(e)(1) of Appendix D-2 to the Indian Tribe Trust Agreement. The Project also includes a light duty zero emission vehicle ("ZEV") component under Section 9 of Appendix D-2.

The Yakama Nation's Project would deploy one all new diesel bus servicing the Yakama Nation's tribal school. The new school bus will be a new Thomas rear engine diesel school bus, Model Profile: Thomas Built Buses Saf-T-Liner HDX 141YS. The eligible vehicle it is replacing is a 2005 Thomas school bus, License Plate I-02623 VIN 4UZAAXCSX5CU30952. This bus is an "Eligible Bus" under Section 2 of Appendix D-2 to the Indian Tribe Trust Agreement because it is a diesel bus that is older than 2009 and has a Gross Vehicle Weight Rating greater than 14,001 lbs. This bus will be rendered inoperable (meaning, at a minimum, it will have a 3-inch hole cut in the engine block and its frame rails will be cut completely in half) and the remaining usable parts will made available for use on the other two 2005 Thomas school buses that are currently being used by the Yakama Nation's tribal school.

The Yakama Nation's Project also includes a light duty ZEV component. Section 9 of Appendix D-2 permits beneficiaries to use up to 15% of their funds "on the costs necessary for, and directly connected to, the acquisition, installation, operation and maintenance of new light duty zero emission vehicle supply equipment for projects specified below." The Yakama Nation intends to use up to that full amount to install a light duty ZEV charging station, with the final number of chargers dictated by the approved budget and actual installation costs. The Yakama Nation intends to install two Level 2 chargers, like the ChargePoint CT4025-GW1 Gateway Unit at \$8,210 apiece and the ChargePoint CT4025 unit at \$7,695 apiece. The installation costs are not estimated to exceed \$15,000, and are currently budgeted at \$12,576.25 to comply with the 15% limit.

The Yakama Nation believes the Project will result in several significant air quality and community benefits, including but not limited to substantially reduced tailpipe emissions (including NOx), reduced greenhouse gas emissions, better vehicle performance and propulsion system durability, and increased comfort for the operator and passengers.

### **Estimate Of Anticipated NOx Reductions (5.2.3)**

The Yakama Nation does not have exact information on the NOx emissions from the vehicle it is replacing, Accordingly, the Yakama Nation used the Diesel Emissions Quantifier (DEO) tool provided by the United States Environmental Protection Agency to calculate the anticipated NOx reduction. The Yakama Nation has four school buses it is seeking to replace, and has the following estimates for the average annual mileage and idling time for those four vehicles: the first school bus will average about 36,500 miles per year and about 130 hours of idling per year, the second school bus will average about 31,286 miles per year and about 130 hours of idling per year, the third school bus will average about 28,679 miles per year and about 130 hours of idling per year, and the fourth school bus will average about 26,000 miles per year and about 118 hours of idling per year. The Yakama Nation took the average of these 4 buses equal to annual mileage of 30,616 miles and annual idling time of 127 hours—and input 4 "average" buses into the DEO tool. In order to calculate the diesel fuel input, the Yakama Nation multiplied the DEO tool's default annual fuel (1,360 gallons) times the Yakama Nation's average mileage (30,616 miles) divided by the DEQ tool's default annual mileage (14,084 miles) to come up with 2,956 gallons. The Yakama Nation used these numbers to run a calculation on annual NOx for the buses with a 2005 model year, which resulted in 0.819 annual tons of NOx, and to run a calculation on annual NOx for the buses with a 2017 model year, which resulted in 0.085 annual tons of NOx. The result is an annual NOx reduction of 0.734 tons per year, or 1,468 pounds per year, for the four buses.

As such, for the Yakama Nation's Project involving the replacement of one school bus, the Yakama Nation anticipates an annual NOx reduction of 367 pounds per year.

### Describe How The Beneficiary Will Make Documentation Publicly Available (5.2.7.2)

The Yakama Nation will maintain and make publicly available all documentation submitted in support of its funding request and all records supporting all expenditures of any funds it receives, subject to applicable laws governing the publication of confidential business information and personally identifiable information. In response to any inquiry from the public, such documentation shall be made publicly available by appointment for review at tribal headquarters. In addition, under Section 5.3 of the Indian Tribe Trust Agreement the Trustee will post on its public-facing website the semiannual reports submitted to the Trustee by the Yakama Nation.

The Yakama Nation's certification of Section 7 of its Certification for Beneficiary Status Under Environmental Mitigation Trust Agreement is subject to the Yakama Nation's governing policies on the release of its records, which establishes the Yakama Nation's position on the procedures for making records publicly available and on the handling of requests by outside parties for the release of various categories of tribal records and the procedures for handling such requests. The Yakama Nation protects from disclosure privileged and protected information.

### Describe How The Beneficiary Complied With Subparagraph 4.2.8, Related To Notice To U.S. Government Agencies (5.2.9)

The Yakama Nation certifies that it has been more than 30 Days since the Yakama Nation was deemed a Beneficiary pursuant to subparagraph 4.0.2.1 of the Indian Tribe Trust Agreement, and that the Yakama Nation has not provided a copy of the Indian Tribe Trust Agreement with Attachments to any Federal Agency since no Federal Agency has notified the Yakama Nation of its interest thereunder. The Yakama Nation further certifies that it will provide a copy of the Indian Tribe Trust Agreement with Attachments to the U.S. Department of the Interior, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, and any other Federal Agency that has custody, control, or management of land within or contiguous to the territorial boundaries of the Yakama Nation and has notified the Yakama Nation of its interest thereunder, explaining that the Yakama Nation may request Eligible Mitigation Action funds for use on lands within that Federal Agency's custody, control, or management (including, but not limited to, Clean Air Act Class I and II areas), and setting forth the procedures by which the Yakama Nation will review, consider, and make a written determination upon each such request, within 30 days of receipt of such notice.

### ATTACHMENT B

### Eligible Mitigation Action Management Plan Including Detailed Budget And Implementation And Expenditures Timeline (5.2.4)

### PROJECT SCHEDULE AND MILESTONES

The Yakama Nation estimates the Yakama Nation's Project will conclude about one year after the funds are distributed, in May 2020. It can be broken into the following steps:

### Step 1. Trustee Award (2 months) [May 2019]

The Yakama Nation's Project will not begin until the Trustee has distributed funds to the Yakama Nation. The Yakama Nation assumes this will occur by May 2019. The consultant application fee will be expended when the funds are distributed.

### Step 2. Bus Procurement and delivery (11 months) [April 2020]

This step will include purchasing the new bus and rendering the old bus inoperable. The Yakama Nation anticipates a bus delivery time of about 9 months after the bus is ordered. The funds for the bus will be expended when the bus is ordered, and the school bus accessories will be purchased when the bus is delivered. Once the new bus is delivered, the bus being replaced will be rendered inoperable, and the funds for that will be expended at that time. Any delivered vehicles will be registered and insured by the Yakama Nation.

### Step 3. Light Duty ZEV Installation (11 months) [April 2020]

This step involves finalizing plans for the charging station and seeking the necessary permits from local authorities to install the systems. During this step, the Yakama Nation will be working with Yakama Power to develop a site and installation plan for the charging stations, including any site engineering (such as civil, electrical, and mechanical), construction, and equipment installation. The costs for the charging infrastructure equipment will be expended when the parts are ordered once the site design is complete. The costs for the charging infrastructure installation will be expended as infrastructure is completed.

The Yakama Nation anticipates that steps 2 and 3 can mostly be performed simultaneously.

### Step 4. Project Completion (1 month) [May 2020]

Once the replaced bus is rendered inoperable and the charging station is installed, the Yakama Nation will issue a final report summarizing implementation and will close out the project with the Trustee. Assuming that the award occurs in May 2019, the Yakama Nation estimates project completion will occur in May 2020. The consultant implementation fee will be expended when the project is complete.

### YAKAMA NATION ADMINISTRATIVE BUDGET

The Yakama Nation also intends to allocate a portion of its budget to internal administrative costs. The Yakama Nation estimates that its internal administrative costs will be about \$7,100.00 based on the following administrative expenditure estimates: \$1,000 for personnel cost for bus project (50 hours at \$20/hour), \$400.00 for personnel fringe expense for bus project (at 40%), \$2,000.00 for personnel cost for light duty ZEV project (100 hours at \$20/hour), \$800.00 for personnel fringe expense for bus project (at 40%), \$400.00 for general office expenses, and \$2,500.00 for insurance and construction costs. These costs will be expended as a reimbursement when the project is complete.

### PROJECT BUDGET

The Yakama Nation estimates the budget for the Yakama Nation's Project will be, as shown in detail in the table below. Since this slightly exceeds the maximum approved budget of \$250,774.00, the Yakama Nation is requesting the maximum approved budget be funded.

### Detailed Plan For Reporting On Eligible Mitigation Action Implementation (5.2.11)

No later than six months after the Yakama Nation receives its first disbursement of Trust Assets, and thereafter no later than January 30 (for the preceding six-month period of July 1 to December 31) and July 30 (for the preceding six-month period of January 1 to June 30) of each year, the Yakama Nation shall submit to the Trustee a semiannual report describing the progress implementing the Yakama Nation's Round 1 School Bus Replacement Project during the six-month period leading up to the reporting date (including a summary of all costs expended on the Eligible Mitigation Action through the reporting date).

The Yakama Nation's reports shall include a complete description of the status (including actual or projected termination date), development, implementation, and any modification of the Yakama Nation's Project. The Yakama Nation does not anticipate that these reports will be onerous because the Project primarily consists of obtaining a new bus. If necessary, the Yakama Nation will engage the services of external vendors to review and/or audit these reports. These reports shall be signed by an official with the authority to submit the report for the Yakama Nation and will contain an attestation that the information is true and correct and that the submission is made under penalty of perjury.

### **ATTACHMENT D**

### <u>Potailed Cost Estimates From Selected Or Potential Vendors</u> <u>For Each Proposed Expenditure Exceeding \$25,000 (5.2.6)</u>

Attachment D includes a cost estimate for the new bus from Schetky Northwest Sales, the local Thomas school bus dealer.

For the charging station, the Yakama Nation intends to work with its own Yakama Power, which does not anticipate making any charges exceeding \$15,000 so a detailed cost estimate is not required. Cost estimates from greenways2go.com for the ChargePoint CT4025-GW1 Gateway Unit (\$8,210 apiece) and ChargePoint CT4025 (\$7,695 apiece) are attached.

Attachment D also includes a consultant administrative fee request from the Askman Law Firm, LLC setting forth fees incurred thus far in preparing the application along with an estimate for future implementation efforts.

The Askman Law Firm, L.L.C. is pleased to have had the opportunity to assist the Yakama Nation with their application for the first round of VW trust funds. This letter serves as the Firm's fee request to be submitted as part of the Yakama Nation's application. The Firm is requesting a fee to be funded as an eligible administrative expense with trust funds the Yakama Nation receives. The Firm is requesting a fee for the Firm's services already provided, along with an estimated fee based on the services the Firm anticipates providing following approval of the application. These fees will be in addition to any trust funds received by the Yakama Nation. This Fee Request has been amended in response to the Trustee's April 8, 2019 email in which the Trustee requested that certain revisions be made. Since the requested revisions were due to oversights by the Firm, the Firm has not requested any additional fees for the revisions.

As you are aware, the Firm informed the Yakama Nation of their eligibility to become a beneficiary under the Trust Agreement. The Firm also advised the Yakama Nation on how they could benefit from becoming a beneficiary, including providing the Yakama Nation with an analysis of the amount of funds the Yakama Nation should receive from the trust and preparation of an application strategy to maximize that value for the Yakama Nation. When the Yakama Nation decided to apply to become a beneficiary and apply for trust funds, the Firm assisted the Yakama Nation in preparing its application.

The Firm is submitting its fee request to be paid from trust funds awarded to the Yakama Nation as an eligible administrative expense under the Trust Agreement. Appendix D-2 to the Trust Agreement includes a section for "Eligible Mitigation Action Administrative Expenditures." That section permits the Yakama Nation, as a Beneficiary, to "use Trust Funds for actual administrative expenditures (described below) associated with implementing such Eligible Mitigation Action, but not to exceed 15% of the total cost of such Eligible Mitigation Action." That section goes on to describe eligible administrative expenditures to include, *inter alia*, "[c]ontractual including all contracted services," "[c]ontracts for evaluation and

consulting services," and "[o]ther costs including ... professional services." It also specifies certain items that do not quality as eligible administrative expenditures, including fees prior to October 2, 2017 and any expenses in preparing an Appendix D-3. The services that the Firm provided to the Yakama Nation in preparing its application, as well as the services that the Firm will provide to the Yakama Nation in implementing its project, qualify under those provisions and the guidance provided by the Trustee and the U.S. Department of Justice.

As of the time of this Fee Request, the Firm is requesting a fee of \$16,355.00 for assisting the Yakama Nation with their application for VW trust funds. Additional detail is provided in the attached invoice, including a description of the person who worked on the matter, the date of the work, the time spent on the task, the task performed, and the hourly rate for the work.

The Firm estimates that any future assistance provided to the Yakama Nation in implementing the project will cost take about \$9,100.00, based on 26 hours at \$350 per hour. We estimate the hours based on performing the following tasks: 2 hours for contracting and purchase of the new bus; 2 hours for finalizing the charging station details; 2 hours for arranging for rendering the old bus inoperable; 15 hours for preparation of status reports on the project; and 5 hours for closing out the project including preparation of a final report.
