## Trustee Descriptive Report for Period July 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019

As required under subparagraphs 3.3.1.6 and 3.3.1.7

### Establishment, Purpose, and Funding of the Indian Tribe Trust

On October 25, 2016, Volkswagen AG ("VW") and certain subsidiaries entered into a Partial Consent Decree, and on May 17, 2017 entered into a Second Partial Consent Decree, in the United States District Court, Northern District of California (the "Court"), which required VW to make payments in the amounts of \$2.7 billion and \$225 million, respectively, to fulfill their environmental mitigation obligations pursuant to the Decrees. The Consent Decrees required the Settling Defendants to establish the Environmental Mitigation Trust for Indian Tribe Beneficiaries (the "Indian Tribe Trust" or "Indian Tribe Mitigation Trust") and to fund the Indian Tribe Trust with funds to be used for environmental mitigation projects that reduce emissions of nitrogen oxides ("NOx") where the Subject Vehicles were, are, or will be operated ("Eligible Mitigation Actions"), and to pay for Trust Administration Costs as set forth in the trust agreement of the Indian Tribe Trust (the "Trust Agreement").

On March 15, 2017, the Court appointed Wilmington Trust, N.A. ("WTNA") as the Trustee for Indian Tribe Mitigation Trust. The Indian Tribe Trust's purpose is to fund eligible environmental mitigation projects that reduce emissions of nitrogen oxide. The Indian Tribe Trust also provides for the payment of Trust Administration costs. On October 2, 2017, the Indian Tribe Trust was established and approximately \$41.4 million was deposited into the Trust before the end of 2017.

By the end of 2018, the Trustee received from the Settling Defendants a deposit of approximately \$18 million, which represented the Indian Tribe Trust's portion of the final \$900 million required under the 2.0L Partial Consent Decree, meaning that the Indian Tribe Trust was considered fully funded at the start of this reporting period.

The Environmental Mitigation Trust Agreement for Indian Tribe Beneficiaries (as modified on November 15, 2018) was filed with the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of California on November 30, in accordance with the Order issued by Judge Charles R. Breyer on Friday November 16, 2018 approving the proposed Material Modifications to the Indian Tribe Trust (the "Approval Order"). #### Introduction

In the reporting period (July 1, 2019 to December 31, 2019), WTNA completed a number of actions permitted and required under the Trust Agreement and Consent Decrees, which included application of Per Capita and Pro-Rata Allocation calculations, and notice to each Beneficiary electing to participate in the second funding cycle; reviewing and approving Eligible Mitigation Action Certification (Appendix D-4) Forms for the Second Funding Cycle and funding the approved requests; and, payment of Trust bills. A brief description of each of these actions is included below.

# 3.3.1.7 Actions taken in reporting period in accordance with Trust Agreement and Consent Decrees

### Implementation of Steps for Second Funding Cycle under the Modified Indian Tribe Trust Agreement

In the reporting period, the Trustee implemented a number of actions required for the second funding cycle under the Modified Indian Tribe Trust agreement.

### Application of Per Capita and Pro-Rata Allocation and Notice to Each Participating Beneficiary

In the previous period, the Trustee had received timely-filed Designated Beneficiary's Participation Notices (Appendix D-6) submissions from 49 Beneficiaries, which enabled the Trustee to perform its allocation determinations.

As per subparagraph 5.0.5.3, "in order to ensure an equitable allocation of funds in the Tribal Allocation Subaccount among Beneficiaries to fund Eligible Mitigation Actions to be proposed and administered by the Beneficiaries, the Trustee ... [is required to] apply the allocation method set forth ...[in 5.0.5.3] in each funding cycle.

On July 1, 2019, according to 5.0.5.3.3 the Trustee allocated 50% of the available funding on a Per Capita Allocation and the other 50% of the available funding on a Pro Rata Population-based Allocation. On this date, the Trustee also transmitted an individualized notice to each of the 49 participating Beneficiaries regarding the Trustee's allocation determination of the amount of funding available for each Beneficiary for the second funding cycle.

### Receipt, Approval, and Funding of Beneficiary Eligible Mitigation Action Certification (Appendix D-4) Forms for Second Funding Cycle

In the period, the Trustee received and reviewed Beneficiary Eligible Mitigation Action Certification (Appendix D-4) Forms from 45 federally-recognized Indian Tribes.

From October through November, the Trustee disbursed approximately \$14 million to fund the approved Eligible Mitigation Actions of 43 of the 45 Indian Tribe Trust Beneficiaries detailed in Table 1. Two Indian Tribe Trust Beneficiaries had distributions that were approved, but which were held up pending receipt by the Trustee of additional documentation at the end of the period.

#### Federal Income Taxes

In accordance with the Trust Agreement, the Trustee continues to deduct (and deposit into the Tax Payment Subaccount) estimated federal income taxes from the investment income of the Indian Tribe Trust.

#### State Income Taxes

On August 7, 2019, the Trustee received a private letter ruling ("PLR") from the Delaware Division of Revenue confirming that the Indian Tribe Trust is a Qualified Settlement Fund under Delaware Law and as a Qualified Settlement Fund, the Indian Tribe Trust is not subject to Delaware income tax. Considering the favorable conclusions within the Delaware PLR, the Indian Tribe Trust will no longer make estimated income tax payments to Delaware. As of December 31, 2019, the Trustee was continuing to work with its tax advisors to obtain a refund of all Delaware income taxes paid while the Delaware PLR was pending.

On December 11, 2019, the Trustee received a refund check from the California Franchise Tax Board ("FTB") in the amount of \$1,700. The Trustee has deposited the California refund into the Indian Tribe Trust Tax Subaccount. Based on the refund from the California FTB and advice from its tax advisors, The Indian Tribe Trust will no longer make estimated income tax payments to California.

### Payment of Trust Bills

In the period, the Indian Tribe Trust paid \$13,492 in Trust Administration Costs. The Indian Tribe Trust also paid approximately \$123,077 in costs to third-party professionals.
