There was an initial delay in getting the 2017-2018 EPA agreement signed. DEQ did not recieve a signed agreement until 11/1/42018. Due to internal DEQ delays we were unable to sign new agreements with grantees until 32/62/019. We had difficulty getting much interest during Q3 which may have been due to the season. However, now we have several project partners who either have or are planning to go forward with subawards with a project end date of either 6/30/2020 or 9/30/2020. During Q4 we were able to generate new interest and successfully onboarded the Springfield School District for

We were able to receive an extension for this grant during Q4. During this last quarter we onboarded two new districts and began the onboarding process for a third. Despite issues in previous quarters, at this point we have obligated all funds and are in active communication with all subawardees. The delays that we anticipate now are due to ongoing issues associated with the worldwide pandemic.
