A sub-grant was awarded to the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (MWCOG) in September, 2019 for the locomotive switcher repower project administration. DOEE held a kickoff meeting for the subgrant in 2019 and continues to recieve updates from MWCOG. MWCOG coordinated with Amtrak during the reporting period and has drafted a MOU for signature. The Amtrak project was delayed in March 2020 due to impacts related to COVID-19. The project is expected to pick back up in Q2 and the first switcher is now planned to be repowered by the end of 2021 or beginning of 2022.

In 2019 DOEE put out a request for applications for the DEAL program and received a proposal from DDOT to replace 14 eligible diesel transit buses with electric transit buses. No other proposals were recieved. DDOT and DOEE are working to make sure DDOT can sufficiently expand their space for bus charging stations in order to begin purchasing electric replacement buses under the DEAL program. Agencies will sign a MOU with final award amount and project details with DDOT when this timeline is secured. We anticipate signing the MOU by spring of 2021. While behind our initial workplan schedule, the project is still on track for completion. DOEE requested its first draw from the Trust, which was granted, in February 2020 for administrative work.
