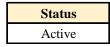

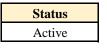

However, NDEE received a complaint from a former employee of the company that alleged that the company's application misrepresented the condition and status of the two old trucks and that neither truck met the eligibility requirements for the rebate. This complaint is under investigation and the reimbursement has not been paid. NDEE contacted the remaining incomplete irrigation engine project managers to request updates on their progress. 2020 Program: The application period for the 2020 Nebraska Clean Diesel Rebate Program ended on 22 January 2021. NDEE received 6 applications to replace 10 diesel trucks and 34 applications to replace diesel irrigation engines. One irrigation engine application was rejected because the engine was not operable and not within the eligible range of engine model years; all other applications were for eligible projects. NDEE elected to increase the Voluntary State Match above that budgeted in the workplan in order to award rebates to all eligible projects. Agreements have been signed and Commence Work notices have been issued for all projects.
