Summary

5.2.2

During the fourth funding cycle of the Volkswagen Settlement Environmental Mitigation Trust for Indian Tribes, the Citizen Potawatomi Nation will replace four (4) government-owned eligible diesel vehicles with four (4) low-emission new diesel vehicles.

The following eligible vehicles to be replaced are:

The eligible vehicles will be scrapped and replaced with low-emission new diesel vehicles. The old vehicles will be decommissioned by drilling a three-inch hole in the engine block and disabling the chassis, rendering the vehicle unusable.

The low-emission replacement vehicles that the Citizen Potawatomi Nation will acquire are:

The four new diesel vehicles will be equipped to serve the similar or same purpose as the eligible vehicles being replaced. The total cost of the replacement vehicles will be \$490,953.

The replacement of old diesel vehicles to new low-emission diesel vehicles will benefit the community by reducing pollution, including reduced emissions of NOx, reduced emissions of noise, reduced fuel consumption, and reduced fuel cost.

5.2.3

The Eligible Mitigation Action will result in a significant reduction in NOx emissions, other pollutants, and fuel consumption. According to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's Diesel Emissions Qualified (DEQ), the Eligible Mitigation Action will result in an 84.8 % annual

reduction in NOx emissions and annual reductions of PM2.5 of 98.9%; HC 93.2% and CO 40.7%. The project will result in annual reduction of 0.916 NOx, short tons (based on average results for the four eligible replacement vehicles).

Lifetime reduction of NOx is 79.0%, and lifetime reductions of PM2.5 are 97.4%; HC 86.9% and CO -8.5%. The project will result in a lifetime reduction of 1.975 NOx, short tons (based on average results for the four eligible replacement vehicles).

Detailed data are attached to this Addendum.

5.2.7.1

The governmental entity responsible for reviewing and auditing expenditures of eligible Mitigation Action Funds to ensure compliance with applicable law is the Citizen Potawatomi Nation Department of Environmental Protection.

5.2.7.2

The Citizen Potawatomi Nation will provide a notice in the local newspaper dedicated to the funding received from the VW Settlement Trust, which will include information for members of the public to request additional information and documents related to the funding request and expenditure of funds.

The Citizen Potawatomi Nation will endeavor to respond to such requests within fifteen (15) business days and, when documents are requested, will advise the individual within that timeframe of the procedure for reviewing such documents. The Citizen Potawatomi Nation follows Citizen Potawatomi Nation's Constitution and Ordinances for matters governing the publication of confidential business information and personally identifiable information, and exemptions thereto.

5.2.8

The total cost of the project is \$490,953. It has been determined that the Citizen Potawatomi Nation is eligible for \$480,456 from the Environmental Mitigation Trust in the fourth funding cycle. All eligible money will be used for the project with a tribal contribution of \$10,497.

5.2.9

The Citizen Potawatomi Nation has complied with Section 4.2.8 of the Indian Tribe Trust Agreement. No federal agencies expressed interested or contacted the Citizen Potawatomi Nation about the VW Settlement.

Not applicable.

The combined results for vehicle upgrades in the project are from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency Diesel Emissions Quantifier.

These results are for all eligible replacement vehicles, three Class 8 and one Class 7. All four (4) of these vehicles will be replaced in this Environmental Mitigation Action.




