2. Group PBPNR&B – 2006 Peterbilt 379

Status Update: Incomplete. Lead Agency provided VW budget allowance to Group PBPNR&B (PBPN Road & Bridge Director). Group PBPNR&B coordinating with the Tribe's Finance Department to address budget needs to complete unit replacement – meeting date unknown at time of report submission. The Tribe will submit quarterly progress reports according to the Trust Agreement reporting requirements.
