Explanation of how funding request fits into Beneficiary's Mitigation Plan (5.2.1):

The Beneficiary Mitigation Plan's overarching goal is to protect New Mexico's environment and the health of our citizens. The Trust allows the State the opportunity to offset (mitigate) the impact of excess nitrogen oxide (NO_X) emissions associated with the affected vehicles registered within New Mexico. The reduction of NO_X from mobile sources achieves the intended use of Trust funds by preventing the deterioration of air quality, ensuring the health and safety of the inhabitants of the state, and promoting visibility improvement within New Mexico. Implementation of diesel NO_X reduction projects using Trust funds will have immediate and long-lasting benefits. The proposed project will reduce emissions of NO_X , focusing on the most costeffective vehicles that maximize emission reductions.

Detailed Description of Mitigation Action Item Including Community and Air Quality Benefits (5.2.2):

The Estancia Valley Solid Waste Authority is comprised of a Regional Landfill, eight collection stations and one special waste landfill. The roll-off trucks collect solid waste from our centers and dispose at our regional landfill. The project area is primarily in Torrance County. Our service extends beyond Torrance County, as far east as Santa Rosa, North to Las Vegas (San Miguel County), South to Vaughn (Guadalupe County) and West to Albuquerque (Bernalillo County). Our regional landfill and collection services impact several counties and our reduction in emissions will greatly improve the air quality. Our Solid Waste Authority follows environmental justice policies for the disposal of Solid Waste.

Estimate of Anticipated NO_X Reductions (5.2.3):

The total lifetime NO_x reduction for this project is estimated to be 6.22 tons (12,440 pounds)

Identification of Governmental Entity Responsible for Reviewing and Auditing Expenditures of Eligible Mitigation Action Funds to Ensure Compliance with Applicable Law (5.2.7.1):

The New Mexico Environment Department Administrative Services Division is the governmental entity responsible for reviewing and auditing expenditures of EMA funds to ensure compliance.

Describe how the Beneficiary will make documentation publicly available (5.2.7.2):

The New Mexico Environment Department has created a public website, https://www.env.nm.gov/vw-settlement/ for information relating to the Trust, the VW Partial Consent Trust Decrees, New Mexico's Beneficiary Mitigation Plan, and project implementation information. To provide transparency and accountability, the NMED will post information on its website.

Describe any cost share requirement to be placed on each NO_x source proposed to be mitigated (5.2.8): The total project cost is Five Hundred Eighty Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Two dollars (\$580,122.00). Trust funding will provide the requested Five Hundred Eighty Thousand One Hundred Twenty-Two dollars (\$580,122.00), 100% of the final total project cost, towards the purchase of the new trucks.

Describe how the Beneficiary complied with subparagraph 4.2.8, related to notice to U.S. Government Agencies (5.2.9):

On February 27, 2018, NMED sent notice to the U.S. Department of the Interior and the U.S. Department of Agriculture using the contact information provided in subparagraph 4.2.8.

If applicable, describe how the mitigation action will mitigate the impacts of NO_X emissions on communities that have historically borne a disproportionate share of the adverse impacts of such emissions (5.2.10): The VW Mitigation Trust funds have afforded the State the opportunity to advance environmental justice goals. New Mexico's Draft Mitigation Plan expresses a commitment to prioritizing projects that benefit those communities most impacted by poor air quality. Minorities and those living below the poverty level historically have borne a disproportionate share of air pollution, including air pollution emissions associated with non-road and on-road heavy-duty diesel-fueled vehicles. The vehicles proposed for replacement travel on the Interstate, US Highway 285 and several local roadways to transport solid waste from our collection centers that are geographically located throughout the regional surrounding area including Santa Rosa, Las Vegas, Vaughn, Encino, Moriarty, Estancia, Willard, Mountainair, Edgewood and the unincorporated areas in Torrance County. The American Community Survey (Annex 2) lists a population of 22,240 as of 2017. The impact of emission reduction in each of these areas would be instrumental to the air quality that affects several demographics including elderly (4,261), Minority (12,910) which is 58% of the total population and poverty (5,358 Households). Per Capita Income is \$18,571 among the total households, totaling 8096. 5% of the population is between the ages of 0-4 and 19% over the age of 65. There is 3974.29 square miles in our regional area of operation. The population density per square mile is six.

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED), as the lead agency for the State of New Mexico for implementing the Volkswagen Environmental Mitigation Settlement Plan, has established a webpage for the Settlement and mitigations actions, www.env.nm.gov/vw-settlement/. NMED is subject to the Open Meetings Act, which provides the statutory guidelines for conducting public meetings and the Inspection of Public Records Act, which is a New Mexico state law that provides the public and media access to public information.
