Description of Status (include actual or projected termination date):

Bids for all three vehicles were received, but the total cost exceeded the Round 3 award amount. Therefore, the scope of this round was reduced and only the two originally proposed water trucks will be purchased (the tractor truck was removed from the scope of this round). Additionally, an invitation to bid was prepared and advertised for the installation of light duty zero emission charging equipment and infrastructure. Due to delays caused by the COVID pandemic, project completion (procurement and scrapping) is not expected to occur until at least the fourth quarter 2022, approximately 18 months later than the original project schedule.

Development (planning work accomplished for the project):

A re-invitation for bid for the three vehicles and the light duty zero emission charging equipment and infrastructure was prepared and published.

Implementation (purchases, construction/installation of infrastructure, etc.):

A contract was put in-place for the purchase of two water trucks. Construction of the vehicles is pending.

Bids for all three vehicles were received, but the total cost exceeded the Round 3 award amount. Therefore, the scope of this round was reduced and only the two originally proposed water trucks will be purchased (the tractor truck was removed from the scope of this round).
