

Expected project completion is September 2023. No project modifications made during this reporting period.

EMA 1: Eligible Large Trucks	Class 8 Local Eligible Large Trucks	\$1,248,585 obligated by Virginia DEQ by a contractual agreement with a public body to replace heavy duty diesel transfer and refuse trucks with electric trucks and associated charging infrastructure. Project is expected to be completed by June 2023. No project modifications made during this reporting period.
