2020, December 2020, July 3	2021, and October 2021). Notification of application rounds are posted a month beforehand on raqc.org,							
cleanairfleets.org, and cdph	e.colorado.gov/Volkswagen-diesel-emissions-settlement. Email notifications are sent to listservs hosted by the							
Colorado Department of He	alth and Environment and the Regional Air Quality Council. After the application round closes, applications are							
reviewed, and applicants are	e notified of their award status. Following award notification, awarded applicants attend a training meeting and/or							
webinar and then are issued	a purchase order which grants permission to proceed with purchasing new equipment and scrapping old							
equipment.
