Project Narrative				

This semiannual report documents the progress and implementation for the Transit Bus Replacement Program throughout the State of Colorado. Funds for Class 4-8 transit buses are awarded through the CDOT Consolidated Call for Capital Projects (CCCP) and administered by the CDOT Division of Transit & Rail (DTR). This semiannual report documents the progress of implementing funding approved under the D4 beneficiary project ID CDOT 9A18DD for funding request No. 1. A revision to funding request No.1 was submitted to the Trust on August 27, 2021 to increase funding for the Transit Bus Replacement Program.

#### **Summary of Monthly Activities**

To date, the Transit Bus Replacement Program has completed five rounds of annual awards, beginning with the application period in September 2018 and resulting in the first round of award announcements in April 2019. A second annual award cycle was opened in October 2019 and award announcements were made on March 23, 2020. The third annual award cycle was opened in August 2020 with award announcements made in March 2021. A fourth round of awards was opened for application in June 2021 and closed in September 2021, but unfortunately no eligible project applications were submitted in this most recent round. A fifth round of awards opened for application on July 5<sup>th</sup>, 2022 and closed on September 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2022, with award announcements in January 2023. A sixth round of funding is anticipated to open in August 2023, with award announcements expected in early 2024.

Public notification of application periods is posted approximately six weeks prior to the submission deadline on CODOT.gov, colorado.gov/cdphe/VW, and elsewhere. Email notifications are sent to listservs managed by CDOT and its partner agencies across the state. After the application round closes, applications are reviewed and scored by an inter-agency committee and applicants are notified of their award status.

Notes: Funds for awardees will be paid upon delivery of the bus. Delivery of electric transit buses can take 12-18 months.

Following award notification, awarded applicants attend a training webinar and then develop a scope of work and contract with CDOT, which grants them permission to proceed with purchasing new equipment and scrapping old equipment.

Colorado revised its Beneficiary Mitigation Plan (BMP) to align with an executive order issued by Governor Polis in January 2019. Specifically, this executive order directed state agencies to apply all remaining Settlement funds to zero-emission vehicles and infrastructure. The Transit Bus Replacement Program underwent updates to match the revised scope of the new BMP.

This semiannual report documents the progress and implementation for the ALT Fuels Colorado program throughout the state of Colorado. Funds for Class 4-7 local freight, Class 8 local freight, School & Shuttle buses, freight switchers, and airport GSE are awarded through the ALT Fuels Colorado grant program and administered by the Regional Air Quality Council.

#### **Summary of Monthly Activities**

To date, the Alt Fuels Colorado grant program has completed seven application rounds (September 2018, January 2019, October 2019, March 2020, December 2020, July 2021, and October 2021). Notification of application rounds are posted a month beforehand on ragc.org, cleanairfleets.org, and cdphe.colorado.gov/Volkswagen-diesel-emissions-settlement. Email notifications are sent to listservs hosted by the Colorado Department of Health and Environment and the Regional Air Quality Council. After the application round closes, applications are reviewed, and applicants are notified of their award status. Following award notification, awarded applicants attend a training meeting and/or webinar and then are issued a purchase order which grants permission to proceed with purchasing new equipment and scrapping old equipment.

The tables that follow below are reflective of all active projects funded through VW. Projects that have been outlined in previous versions of this report, and the entire funding request has since closed, have been removed from the tables. Additionally, projects that have not been included



on a D4 funding request are not outlined below. Due to project cancellations and returned funds, staff is assessing the best approach for including those projects on future D4 submissions.

#### Mitigation Action 9: Electric Vehicle Supply Equipment

This semiannual report documents the progress and implementation for installing Level 2 and DC Fast Charging (DCFC) stations throughout the state of Colorado. The first drawdown of funds includes projects and administrative costs for community and corridor charging stations. Funds for the corridor charging stations are awarded through the program Alt Fuels Colorado, and awards for community charging stations are awarded through the program Charge Ahead Colorado.



#### Charge Ahead Colorado – community-based Level II and DC fast-charging stations

#### **Summary of Activities**

- Funding rounds
  - CEO offered two application rounds during this reporting period in January 2023 & May 2023. Funding allocations were made in January 2023 for the October 2022 CAC round, and the May 2023 rounds will have funding allocations made between July 2023 and August 2023.

#### RFA modifications

CEO staff worked to make updates to the program and application based on the implementation of the Fleet-ZERO program to align with its incentive structure, along with the structure available in the DCFC Plazas program. Charge Ahead Colorado now offers Level 2, 19-49.9 kWh, and DCFC per port incentives. This is also reflected in the enhanced incentives. The Enhanced Incentive Screening tool was also updated as there were new blocks groups added in the shapefile for CDPHE's EnviroScreen tool; this expanded the coverage of eligibility on our map. Additionally, the Application Guide was updated to reflect these changes, as well as refine eligibility. #### Web updates

 Regular updates are made to reflect the upcoming funding rounds and available funding. A new website will be launched later this CY 2023 as part of the effort to expand on website accessibility. This will likely result in changes to the Charge Ahead Colorado website as well as the grant management software platforms.

#### Outreach materials

- CEO staff participated in various outreach webinars and presentations from January 2023 through June 2023 to educate past applicants and interested parties on updates to the Charge Ahead Colorado program.
