Explanation of how funding request fits into Beneficiary's Mitigation Plan (5.2.1):

The Louisiana Department of Environmental Quality's Beneficiary Mitigation Plan, published in April 2018, identified the replacement of eligible diesel vehicles and heavy equipment with new, less polluting engines. This funding request will replace one (1) 1999 model year diesel forklift truck with a 2023 model year, Class 5, heavy-duty forklift truck and one (1) 1995 model year articulating boom lift with a 2024 model year, Class 6, articulating boom lift.

Detailed Description of Mitigation Action Item Including Community and Air Quality Benefits (5.2.2):

The replacement of the forklift truck and articulating boom lift will focus on NO_x emission reductions. However, it will also achieve reductions in other emissions, including Sulfur Dioxide (SO₂), Volatile Organic Compounds (VOCs), Particulate Matter (PM), and Hazardous Air Pollutants (HAPs). NO_x is a criteria pollutant with a National Ambient Air Quality Standard (NAAQS). NO_x is also a precursor for ozone and PM. Breathing air with a high concentration of NO_x can irritate airways in the human respiratory system. Such exposures over short periods can aggravate respiratory diseases, particularly asthma, leading to respiratory symptoms (such as coughing, wheezing or difficulty breathing), hospital admissions and visits to emergency rooms. Longer exposures to elevated concentrations of NO_x may contribute to the development of asthma and potentially increase susceptibility to respiratory infections. People with asthma, as well as children and the elderly are generally at greater risk for the health effects of NO_x.

Estimate of Anticipated NO_x Reductions (5.2.3):

0.11 metric tons/year and 0.84 metric tons/lifetime.

LDEQ will provide one hundred percent (100%) funds towards the purchase of replacement diesel-powered equipment/vehicles. The amount provided shall be limited to one hundred percent (100%) of the purchase price and shall not exceed that amount.

Describe how the Beneficiary complied with subparagraph 4.2.8, related to notice to U.S. Government Agencies (5.2.9).

Notice to U.S. Government Agencies was emailed on August 23, 2018.

All areas of Louisiana are currently designated attainment with all NAAQS, except St. Bernard Parish that is designated nonattainment for SO₂. However, Louisiana has achieved significant reductions in SO₂ in St. Bernard Parish and monitors currently meet the SO₂ NAAQS. By concentrating on school buses, Louisiana will provide significant emission reductions both for NOx and Toxic Air Pollutants (TAPs).


