As we have been communicating, the Volkswagen Diesel Emissions Environmental Mitigation Trust for State Beneficiaries, Puerto Rico, and the District of Columbia is approaching the 10th anniversary of the Trust Modification Effective Date on October 2, 2027. Wilmington Trust, N.A., as Trustee, is requesting your review and confirmation of the information below as it is a critical component of meeting the 80% "obligated" and 80% "expended" deadlines to become a Supplemental Funding Beneficiary who is entitled to retain all of its original allocation and also become eligible to receive any funds from the re-allocation of the Remainder Balance. It is our goal to identify any issues in your records that do not align with our records as soon as possible and resolve them now. 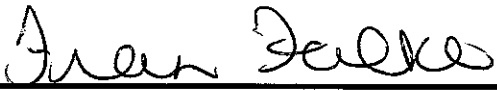
